

Moose Mountain Park ATV Trails

Earlier this year, SATVA partnered with Saskatchewan Parks and the National Trail Coalition, through grant funding provided by the Federal Government, to rehabilitate a portion of the ATV trails in Moose Mountain Provincial Park. The trails, currently known as Bennett Lake and Horse Lake trails are being upgraded to ensure their usability during inclement weather and to ensure a family friendly ATV trail system in the park.

As part of the process, Saskatchewan Parks has engaged MMM Group to perform consultations on the ATV trails in the Park which will be used to assess this and further projects regarding ATV usage in the park. MLA Letter – ATV Registration

We need your support. If you haven't sent in your letter to your MLA already please consider doing so. You can find a "fillable" letter to your MLA that you can send in on our website www.satva.ca or on our Facebook group. If you're not sure who your MLA is you can find out at this web site <http://www.legassembly.sk.ca/>. Please pass this post along to anyone you feel might be interested.

Even if you aren't in favour of ATV registration it is still important to contact your MLA and discuss ATV issues with him/her. They need to know that ATViNG in the province is growing (especially in the recreation area) and that the government needs to take the issues seriously.

B.C. ATV Registration

B.C has postponed its registration requirements for ATV's to November 1, 2015. We've been advised that Saskatchewan based ATV's will not need to be registered provided that you can provide proof of ownership and sales tax paid (bill of sale or receipt from the dealer) and proof of insurance, when requested. If you want to register your ATV voluntarily in BC, please be advised that they will collect BC sales tax on the value of your ATV.

ATV training is required, by law, for anyone 12 to 15 years old (and anyone who doesn't have a driver's license), when operating on public property.
